The Rhode Island FFA Alumni will offer full scholarships to be awarded to **(2)** deserving FFA members to reimburse them for the cost of registration and travel to the 2011 National FFA Washington Leadership Conference. Located in our nation's capitol, the Washington Leadership Conference is a five-day event that trains FFA members to focus on knowing their purpose, valuing people, taking action and serving others.

It is the intent of the Rhode Island FFA Alumni that students attending WLC will return with the knowledge and confidence to act in ways that will help their schools, local community and our state. We want to select Rhode Island FFA members who have (A) been using opportunities in FFA to build their leadership skills, (B) have been practicing those skills to solve problems in their chapter and community and (C) who will commit to implementing the skills gained in WLC to challenges they see here at home.

Applicants will be evaluated on their FFA and leadership experience and the belief by the committee in the students ability to implement the knowledge and skills honed during their WLC experience. The student will be interviewed by the scholarship committee on the evening of **Wednesday, April 20, 2011 at 6 p.m.**

Upon their return the attendees will be invited to make a presentation at an alumni meeting, sharing with the members their experiences and plans to implement some of their leadership strategies.

Those applicants who successfully complete WLC and who are attending the following National Convention will be expected to participate in the WLC dinner if their schedule permits and the alumni will cover the cost of the ticket. This is a meaningful final session of WLC and an excellent opportunity to network with other premier FFA members from across the country.
